Information Guide and Sample Questions **Intra/Extra Oral Computerized Examination**

This computerized examination will consist of 50 multiple choice questions, where some questions may have photographs for identification of oral conditions. The examination will have a 1-hour time limit.

Some topics this exam will cover, but is not limited to:

- Document findings in patient records
- Conditions of the oral cavity
- Normal and abnormal anatomy
 - For example: Candidiasis amalgam tattoo or geographic tongue
- Reasons for antibiotic premedication
- Medical conditions which might affect the oral cavity

5. Which oral hygiene aid would NOT be useful for a Dental Hygienist to recommend for a patient recently diagnosed with arthritis in both hands?
